BASIC VENUE INFORMATION

There is no step-free or wheelchair access to the venue. There is no hearing loop. There is no accessible toilet. The venue is on the first floor of the Oxford Arms. The Oxford Arms will be open on the ground floor offering food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks, and free drinking water.

TIMINGS

The runtime of the play is 50-60 minutes, with no interval. The Oxford Arms is open from 12pm-1am every day.

CONTENT

TW: Bestiality, Sexual Assault, Verbal Abuse, mental illness, hallucinations, threat of child death. There may be some flashing lights, loud shouting, and loud music during the performance.

SEATING

The venue's seating is a fixed rake.

ADDITIONAL ACCESS INFORMATION

Assistance dogs are permitted in all parts of the venue. Currently there are no plans for a relaxed/accessible performance, though please watch for updates on this.

PHOTOGRAPHY/FILMING

One night of the event may be filmed. If this affects the performance you are attending, it will be clearly designated. The camera will not have any audience members in its sight line.

GETTING TO THE VENUE

There is no reserved accessible parking or on-street parking at the venue. The closest reserved spaces for Blue Badge holders are available on Hawley Crescent, a 1-minute walk/ 0.1 miles from the venue. Other options available include spaces on Arlington Road, 2 minutes/ 0.1 miles away, or Oval Road, 3 minutes/ 0.2 miles. Bus stops are roughly a 3-minute/ 0.1 mile walk away, for services including the 88 and N20. The Camden Town tube station is a 3-minute/ 0.1 mile walk from the venue.
