The Museum is all on one level via 16 steps or an accessible lift from street level down.

Seats in our bar and venue areas are wooden with cushioned seats, high backs and no armrests and are 15" wide and 16" deep.

We have one accessible toilet with baby change, and breastfeeding parents are welcome in our venue. Please be aware though that individual shows may set age restrictions.

Our main block of five toilets is unisex - and we also have two separate cubicles at the far end of the bar area.

The Museum of Comedy is an LGBTQ+ Safe Space and has signed up to the Mayor of London's new Women's Night Safety Charter.

Assistance dogs are extremely welcome to the venue, and unemployed dogs are welcome in the bar area but entry to shows must be considered on a case-by-case basis. Please get in touch!

The doors will open from 3.45pm. The show will run for 60 minutes from 4pm to 5pm on Sunday 6th August 2023. There will be no interval.
