

Pirates: You Wouldn't Steal a Boat – Accessibility Rider

LOCATION: The Museum of Comedy, The Undercroft, St George's Church, Bloomsbury Way, London, WC1A 2SR

DATE & TIME: August 5th 2023, 4 pm

BASIC VENUE INFO: The Museum is all on one level, accessible via 16 steps or a lift from street level which goes down to the venue. The venue has one accessible toilet with baby changing facilities. The venue has another seven toilets, five unisex and two cubicles. Assistance dogs are welcome at the venue, and entry of unemployed dogs will be considered on a case-by-case basis. The venue does not have a cloakroom.

TIMINGS OF EVENT: The venue bar will be open one hour before the show starts (3pm), and the venue will close by 10.30pm. The show is fifty minutes long and contains no interval, please feel free to take an access break at any point throughout.

CONTENT OF EVENT: The show contains occasional strong language and some sexual references, the show contains sustained references to drinking alcohol. There will be occasional instances of flashing lights.

SEATING: Seats in the bar and venue areas are wooden with cushioned seats, high backs and no arm rests. The seats are 15" wide and 16" deep. Seats can be reserved for those with additional needs by contacting the venue.

ADDITIONAL ACCESS INFORMATION: The show will not contain closed captions or a BSL interpreter.

PHOTOGRAPHY/ FILMING: Whilst the venue does not have a strict policy on filming and photography, we would prefer it if you did not take photos or videos during the performance.

GETTING TO THE VENUE: The Museum of Comedy is located on Bloomsbury Way in Bloomsbury, close to the British Museum. It is a six minute walk from either Tottenham Court Road or Holborn tube stations. The Museum is an 18 minute walk from Euston Station, and is also close to a number of local bus routes. There is no local parking at the museum, the nearest car parks are:

Bloomsbury Square Car Park, WC1A 2RJ and Shaftesbury Car Park, Museum Street, WC1A 1JP.

Both of which have blue badge parking.
